- Call to order Meeting called to order by Cynthia Morrill.
- Minutes Minutes of February 27, 2009, reviewed and approved with corrections.
- Self Introductions The planned agenda was reviewed briefly to allow for a longer discussion with our "Guest Stars" of the day, Dr. Jan Muto, President of RCC, and Dr. Pat Schwerdtfeger, Vice President of Academic Affairs.
